Developing a campus focused on reducing carbon emissions not only helps mitigate the effects of climate change but also inspires others to follow in these footsteps.




## Key Interventions

## Target Beneficiaries

This centre will be beneficial for people affected by leprosy and other disabilities, and campus residents, who will experience a sustainable environment and gain insights on reducing carbon footprints.



## Expected outcome

The zero-carbon campus will contribute to environmental health, supporting the hospital kitchen with fresh produce, and empowering patients and community beneficiaries with practical knowledge on sustainability.
