


Disability Rehabilitation Centre



Project Overview

Under this project, the old section of the hospital at TLM Faizabad will be transformed into a comprehensive, state-of-the-art rehabilitation centre, providing specialised care and support for individuals with disabilities through institution- and communitybased interventions.

A survey revealed high demand for rehabilitation services among people with disabilities in 20 districts. With limited facilities focused on disabilities across Faizabad and neighbouring districts, there is a critical need for specialised care for people with disabilities.




Key Interventions

The project aims at renovating existing facilities to establish a state-of-the-art rehabilitation centre providing diverse age groups with disability prevention and management services, including geriatric rehabilitation. The centre will also be connected with the vocational training centre for training people with disabilities.

Target Beneficiaries

This centre will benefit individuals affected by leprosy with disabilities, people with disabilities in 20 districts of Eastern Uttar Pradesh, and their families, along with students and professionals in disability rehabilitation.





Expected outcome

The centre will provide services in paediatric and geriatric rehabilitation. It will also provide vocational rehabilitation by training people in vocational courses and preparing professionals to get back to their vocation after a gap due to their disabilities. It will be a resource hub for clinical services, research, training, and innovation. Facility enhancements, such as a sensory park and wheelchair training area will support long-term sustainability.


Project Overview




Key Interventions
